Joe H.S. Macquaker is presently a Senior Researcher working at the ExxonMobil Upstream Research Company in Houston. Recently he was an Associate Professor in Petroleum Geology at the Department of Earth Sciences, Memorial University of Newfoundland (St. John's, Canada) and previously a Faculty Member at the University of Manchester. He received both a PhD and Honours degrees from the University of Bristol and was a Postdoctoral Researcher at the University of Sheffield.
