

## Guidelines for preparing Papers

- Make sure to use A4 pages. The text must be justified and adjusted to a 170 x 245 mm box, with a 3 cm top margin and 2 cm left margin.
- Papers should be 20 pages long maximum and 5 pages long minimum, including figures and references.
- **Papers** should be headed by the title, authors' names, company or institution they belong to, and email addresses.
- **MAIN HEADING** (cannot include abbreviations, must be brief, informative and self-explanatory). Please use Arial 12 uppercase and bold
- **Secondary Heading:** Please use Arial 11, bold
- **Text:** Please use Arial 11 (Regular).  
Authors' email addresses must be included following their names, single-spaced and with the same font size as the text. Make sure not to use bold.
- **Epigraphs:** Please use Arial 10.
- **Keywords:** Please include keywords in bold (maximum five) following authors' email addresses, and separated by a single-space. They should not be centered and must be either in Spanish or English depending on the language used in the Paper. The font size must be the same as the one used for the text.



**Abstract:** *Rock.s and types. History of Discoveries. Main Characteristics. Research about Argentina.*

- **Abstract:** The abstract must follow the key words separated by double – spacing. It must be written in English if the paper is in Spanish (or in Spanish, if the paper is in English). The **abstract** is a concise digest of the content of the paper, and references to literature are not usually included in this section. It should provide information about objectives, available data and study methodology, followed by an analysis and interpretation of the information as well as major results and observations. It must include quantitative data if available and must end with the conclusions and most relevant implications. The abstract is neither an introduction nor a part of the article's introduction.



The translation of the title must follow the word abstract and must be written in italics. Abstract length should not exceed 400 words.

- **Text:** Please separate the abstract from the text with one spacing. The text must follow a logical order: introduction, methodology, results, conclusions, acknowledgements and literature cited (the concept of references should not be used).

It can be divided into two sub-headings: the first one must be written in uppercase, bold and not centered and, the second one in uppercase and lowercase, bold and not centered. They cannot include initial letters or numbers (e.g. A, 1, etc.). The whole text must be written with single-spacing, not indented, without double-spacing in between paragraphs, and margins should be justified.


Citations of other publications included in the text shall be referred to the final literature list under the title: **CITED REFERENCES** which must indicate authors' last names and year of publication between brackets as follows: Caminos (1975). In case there are more than two authors, *et al* should be used (in italics, neither underlined nor in bold), e.g. Pérez *et al.*, (1990). When more than one publication of the same author is cited, they must be separated by commas, e.g. Caminos (1956, 1978).

If cites are fully between brackets, no commas shall be used to separate the author from the year, e.g. (Caminos 1956); If several authors are included in the parenthesis they shall be separated by semicolon, e.g. (Caminos 1975; González Díaz 1986, 1994). If many publications of the same author are cited, letters: a, b, c should be added following the year, and according to the order of publication (Mainardi 1994a).

Please write fossil names or other words in different languages in italics (**neither underlined nor in bold**).

- **Figure format:** 300 DPI TIF-CMYK, in the size desired by the author. They can be ¼ page, ½ page or full page. Please make sure figures are inserted in the text where appropriate.

All illustrations shall be considered figures, including: tables, maps, charts, pictures, etc., and must be consecutively numbered in Arabic numerals in order of appearance. They must be adjusted to the 170 x 245 cm box size. If figures the size of a column are included, they shall fit the column size (maximum 85 x 245 mm). They must be cited in the text as (Fig...), or (Figs...) in plural and must be inserted in the final size and position with the corresponding figure legend, without leaving blank spaces. If maps are added, they must include geographic coordinates (or Gauss-Krueger) and graph scale. They must also include adequate references to symbols, hatch, etc. Make sure pictures included as figures have good resolution and contrast.
